

Quick Sheet: Log into OLDC from GrantSolutions

Audience: Grantees with OLDC and GMM Access

Purpose


The purpose of this Quick Sheet is to provide step-by-step instructions for accessing the Online Data Collection (OLDC) system from the GrantSolutions Login screen.

Note: Grantees with access to OLDC and the GrantSolutions Grants Management Module (GMM) use their current GMM login credentials in GrantSolutions.

Steps


To access OLDC from GrantSolutions:

1. From an Internet browser (such as Internet Explorer Mozilla Firefox, or Google Chrome), go to www.grantsolutions.gov.
2. The “Grants Center of Excellence” Home page appears. Click the button **Login to GrantSolutions**.


